of the UPC Court of Appeal takes place in the premises of the Court of Appeal of the UPC **Nouvel Hémicycle, Court Room on floor -5, 1, rue du Fort Thüngen; L-1499 Luxembourg** on the 15 February 2024. The oral hearing starts at 9:30 CET. The oral hearing is open to the public unless the court decides to make them confidential to the extent necessary in the interest of one of the parties or other affected persons or in the general interest of justice or public order.

2.

Seats are reserved in the hearing room for parties accompanying persons and representatives. Parties, representatives or accompanying persons may be allowed to attend the oral hearing by videoconference. Representatives are required to submit a respective request to the Court not later than one week prior to the day of the hearing in order to allow respective preparation. Upon allowance by the court, the persons mentioned will receive a personal link from

the Registry of the CoA to access to the WEBEX transmission. It is prohibited to share this link with persons not covered by the Court's allowance. No WebEx connection will be provided to members of the public or the media.

3.

The maximum capacity for the members of the public in the Court Room on floor -5 of the Nouvel Hémicycle building is 20 seats. Members of the public and media representatives will be admitted to the Court Room to the extent that seats available.

At the Nouvel Hémicycle building attendees will need to fill in their names in a list in order to be allowed to enter the Court Room on floor -5. Parties, accompanying persons, representatives and members of the public are invited to arrive in good time, also taking into consideration security checks, to allow a start of the hearing on time.

5.

Any video or audio recordings during the oral proceedings or streaming of the oral proceedings are strictly **prohibited**.
